

Parental Survey 2012

445 questionnaires were returned representing a response rate of 41.5%.

Parents gave good performance scores for most of the academic subjects and the chosen performance criteria.

85% Parents gave an EXCELLENT overall performance score. 37% said the school had improved over the last year and only 3% thought that the school's performance was worse.

Parents are most happy with the delivery of Creative Curriculum, Spanish, French, School Communication, School discipline and levels of homework were also pleasing to parents.

As we have now had 4 surveys since I became Head teacher we can now see change over time.
